



Federal Eviction Ban Order Can I Sign the CDC Declaration?

If you falsely sign the CDC Declaration and give it to your landlord, you could go to prison for up to five years and be fined up to \$250,000.

To legally sign, all your answers to the following five questions must be YES:

1. Have you applied for rent assistance through Miami Valley Community Action Partnership?

If NO – apply for assistance with MVCAP

Where can I find help to pay my rent?

MVCAP might be able to help you pay your rent. Apply online at miamivalleycap.org. If you don't have access to the Internet, go to one of our drop-boxes to fill out and submit the application.

2. Is at least one of following statements true? Yes

I will not earn more than \$99,000 in 2020, if filing an individual tax return, or more than \$198,000 in 2020, if filing a joint tax return.

I was not required to report any income in 2019 to the U.S. Internal Revenue Service.

I received an Economic Impact Payment (COVID stimulus check) under the government CARES Act.

3. Is at least one of following statements true?

- I can't pay my full rent because I lost most of my household income.
- I can't pay my full rent because I lost work hours.
- I can't pay my full rent because I lost wages.
- I can't pay my full rent because I lost my job.
- I can't pay my full rent because I had to pay large medical bills and don't have insurance to pay me back. These bills were equal to or more than 7.5% of my annual gross income.

4. Are you doing your best to pay as much rent on time as you can?

5. Is at least one of the following statements true?

- If evicted, I would likely become homeless, meaning I do not have any place to go.
- If evicted, I would need to go to a homeless shelter.
- If evicted, I would have to move in with other people, like family or friends, where we would be in close contact.
