PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Have a total household income at or below 200% Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- Reside in Montgomery, Greene, Darke, or Preble County to receive assistance.

You are **INELIGIBLE** for assistance if you have:

- An active violator-compact suspension.
- An OVI conviction within the last 2 years.
- A felony drug-related conviction within the last 2 years.
- Multiple misdemeanor drug-related convictions in the last 2 years.
- An open warrant in any jurisdiction.
- A pending case in any jurisdiction.
- An active child-support suspension.
- A security or judgment suspension.
- A date-certain suspension.
- Prior MVCAP license-reinstatement assistance in the last 12 months.

EXCEPTIONS MAY APPLY

ALL ASSISTANCE IS SUBJECT TO CURRENT FUNDING LIMITS

NEXT STEPS

If you meet the qualifications, we will need you to provide the following:



Proof of income/zero income for the past 30 days

State-issued identification & Social Security Number





Valid phone number/email address for correspondence

Please note that submitting an application does not guarantee assistance. Staff will review your application and your BMV report to determine eligibility for the program.


